**AN ORDINANCE APPOINT A VILLAGE CLERK
FOR THE VILLAGE OF SAMMONS POINT**

WHEREAS, The corporate authorities of the Village of Sammons Point have established the manner of selection of the Village Clerk;

WHEREAS, pursuant to 5 ILCS 140/3.5 the Village of Sammons Point has the authority and obligation to designate a Village Freedom of Information Officer; and

WHEREAS, the Village President has determined to appoint JULIE PASEL as Village Clerk and designate JULIE PASEL as Freedom of Information Act Officer, as the most qualified and available candidate for those offices, and the Village Board of Trustees has given its advice and consent to that appointment and designation, as applicable;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE VILLAGE PRESIDENT AND BOARD OF TRUSTEES OF THE VILLAGE OF SAMMONS POINT, KANKAKEE COUNTY, ILLINOIS, THAT:

Section 1: Recitals. The foregoing recitals are hereby incorporated into the Ordinance as if fully set forth herein.

Section 2: Appointment of Village Clerk. JULIE PASEL is hereby appointed to the office of Village Clerk, conditioned upon the posting of the bond therefor required by law, taking the oath of office required by law of all Village officers, and the issuance and acceptance of the warrant of commission therefor in such form as required by the Village, for a term commencing with the satisfaction of the foregoing conditions and ending with that date which is twelve (12) months thereafter.

Section 3: Designation of Freedom of Information Act Officer. JULIE PASEL is hereby designated to the position of the Freedom of Information Act Officer on behalf of the Village of Sammons Point, pursuant to 5 ILCS 140/3.5, with all the responsibilities as identified in that Section of the Act.

Section 4: Severability. The various portions of the Ordinance are hereby expressly declared to be severable, and the invalidity of any one portion of this Ordinance shall not affect the validity of any other portions of this Ordinance, which remaining portions shall be enforced to the fullest extent possible.


Section 5: Repeal. All Ordinances or portions of Ordinances previously passed or adopted by the Village of Sammons Point that conflict with or are inconsistent with the provisions of the Ordinance are hereby repealed.

Section 6: Effective Date. This Ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage and approval.
