

**AN ORDINANCE APPOINTING A VILLAGE ATTORNEY
FOR THE VILLAGE OF SAMMONS POINT**

WHEREAS, the Village of Sammons Point has created the office of Village Attorney

WHEREAS, after investigating and considering potential attorneys and law firms as candidates for the office of Village Attorney, the Village President has determined to appoint Brian Hiatt as Village Attorney as the most qualified and available candidate for that office, and the Village Board of Trustees has given its advice and consent to that appointment;

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT ORDAINED BY THE PRESIDENT AND BOARD OF TRUSTEES OF THE VILLAGE OF SAMMONS POINT, KANKAKEE COUNTY, ILLINOIS, THAT:

Section 1. Recitals – The foregoing recitals are hereby incorporated into this Ordinance as if once again fully set forth herein.

Section 2. Appointment of Village Attorney – Brian Hiatt is hereby appointed as Village Attorney conditioned upon the posting of the bond therefor required by law, taking the oath of office required by law of all Village Officers, and the acceptance of the warrant of commission therefor in such form as required by the Village, for a term commencing with the satisfaction of the foregoing conditions and ending with the term of the current Village President.

Section 3. Severability – The various portions of this Ordinance are hereby expressly declared to be severable, and the invalidity of any such portion of the Ordinance shall not affect the validity of any other portions of this Ordinance which shall be enforced to the fullest extent possible.

Section 4. Repeal – All Ordinances or portions of Ordinances previously passed or adopted by the Village of Sammons Point that conflict with or are inconsistent with the provisions of the Ordinance are hereby repealed.

Section 5. Effective Date – This Ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage and approval.
